The 2025 European Physical Society Conference on High Energy Physics (EPS-HEP 2025) will be hosted in Marseille, France from July 7th to 11th 2025.

The scientific program includes invited plenary talks, presentations in topical tracks and a poster session, covering a wide range of subjects, including:

The abstract submission for parallel tracks and posters will close on April 15th. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated based on quality and balance of the programme, and all submitters will be notified of the selection results by May 7th at the latest.

The registration fees (regular and students) will grant access to all sessions, coffee breaks and the welcome cocktail. Early bird fees are granted until April 15th and registration will close on June 15th. On-site registration or payment will not be available, so please make sure to pay the registration fees in advance.

# **Practical information**

Registration and abstract submission are opened on the conference website <u>https://www.eps-hep2025.eu</u>. The conference will start on Monday morning but attendees are encouraged to arrive on Sunday, as the registration desk will be open in the afternoon.

#### Fees

- **Regular Registration** Fees (Access to all sessions, coffee breaks and the welcome cocktail):
  - Reduced €550 (Early bird until April 15th and plenary speakers/conveners)
  - Standard €650 (after April 15th)
- Registration Fees **for students** (Access to all sessions, coffee breaks and the welcome cocktail, available to both undergraduate and graduate students):
  - Reduced €350 (Early bird until April 15th)
  - Standard €450 (after April 15th)
- **Online** Registration Fee: €150
- Accompanying Person: €50 (Covers access to all public events and the conference dinner)
- Options:
  - Conference Dinner: €70 (The capacity is limited. Tickets are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis.)
  - Lunch Box: €20 per day (We recommend for participants to consider this option in case they plan to follow both the late morning and early afternoon session)
  - Childcare: €100 per child (between 4 and 15) for the whole conference. (Lunches are not included but can be booked separately.) (Available until May 15th)

We do not offer a special program for accompanying persons, but the conference secretariat will be happy to help you with information about the city and events in the city during the days of the conference.

# **Remote participation**

For people unable to travel to Marseille for the conference we will offer the possibility to attend the conference online. Plenary sessions will be webcasted and recorded versions of the talks will be – pending permission by the speaker – available for some period after the conference. Parallel sessions will be available through zoom sessions. Zoom links will only be provided to registered participants. Remote presentations for speakers will not be possible.







### Getting to Marseille and accomodation

- By Train: Marseille is well-connected by the <u>French TGV</u> (high-speed train) network, with frequent services from major European cities to Marseille Saint-Charles train station.
- By Plane: <u>Marseille Provence airport</u> offers a wide range of flights, providing direct connections to numerous major cities worldwide.

The conference will take place in the Palais du Pharo in the city centre and can easily be reached by public transport.

For accommodation, a variety of options are available, as highlighted on the <u>tourism office webpage</u>. You can choose from hotels ranging from 2-star to 5-star ratings or opt for apartment rentals to suit your preferences and budget. Early booking is strongly advised to secure the best options.
