Information for speakers and presenters

Parallel talks

In general, the speakers should plan for at least 3 minutes of discussion time after the talk; e.g., if the contribution is scheduled with a length of 20 minutes, a 17-minute talk should be planned. The length of the contributions is available in the <u>timetable</u>, please check the agenda and/or ask the convener of your session. Speakers are asked to upload their slides in pdf (16:9 format) directly to the Indico timetable of the conference, no later than the evening before the relevant session. Please check that you are correctly listed on the scientific programme and that you can upload your slides now. If in doubt, please contact your session conveners (<u>https://indico.in2p3.fr/event/33627/program</u>).

Plenary talks

Plenary talks are expected to be 30 minutes each including questions. Slides in pdf (16:9 format) should be provided to the organisers or uploaded directly to the Indico timetable of the conference, no later than the evening before the relevant session.

Poster presentations

Poster contributions should be of size A0 and portrait orientation. Presenters are expected to print in advance and bring their poster at the conference. We kindly ask the presenters to also upload their poster in pdf format directly to the Indico timetable of the conference, no later than the evening before the poster session.

Remote connection

All conference registrants have access to remote participation on the

We also remind speakers and presenters that we will offer the possibility to submit proceedings, to be published in PoS Proceedings of Science.







Practical information

Registration desk

The conference will start on Monday morning but attendees are encouraged to go and collect their badge and goodies from the registration desk **on Sunday**. It will be open from 16:00 to 19:00. It will also be open on Monday from 08:00.

Food and drinks

Morning and afternoon coffee breaks will be provided to keep you refreshed throughout the conference.

For participants who pre-ordered lunch boxes, the daily menu and allergen information will be provided in the conference newsletter each day. Please note that lunch boxes cannot be booked on-site. However, a variety of lunch options are available nearby—within a 20-minute walk or a 10-minute bus ride—for those who did not include lunch in their registration.

Conference venue

The conference will take place in the <u>Palais du Pharo</u> in the city centre and can easily be reached by public transport. From the "Vieux-Port" (subway station) bus 83 (toward "Métro Rond-Point du Prado") or bus 82 – 82S (toward "Pharo/Catalans") stops at "Le Pharo". The journey takes approximately 7 minutes. By foot it is possible to walk along the left (southern) side of the Vieux-Port, following the waterfront, and continue to the Palais du Pharo. The walk takes approximately 20 minutes. Please pay attention to the fact that, due to ongoing work, the subway is closed from 9:30 pm but free buses follow the <u>same routes</u>.

It is also possible to use the different bicycle-sharing and scooter systems, with a 100% electric fleet , with a 100% electric fleet: <u>LeVélo</u>, <u>VOI</u> and <u>Lime</u>, the first one being the cheaper. There are pay-per-use formulas (€1 for the first 30 minutes, then €0.05/min after that) and 24h passes for LeVélo and two stations are very close to the Palais du Pharo ("Livon-Pasteur" and "Livon-Vieux Port").



Wifi

A local Wi-Fi network will be available for a limited number of participants. The network is called "wifipharo".

For those with phone contracts that include EU roaming, we recommend using a personal mobile hotspot for seamless connectivity. The conference center offers excellent mobile phone coverage, including in the underground auditoriums.

Inclusiveness and support service

To support this goal, we are pleased to offer, for instance, live captioning for all plenary sessions, childcare services (closed for registration) and a breastfeeding room.
